

Condensed Outline of Iron River Township Adopted Ordinances

Ordinance 1, 2, 3, 4 not located as of December 22, 2004. May have been dissolved, combined with other another ordinance, lost, or not properly filed and recorded. Ordinance 22 was not located or stated in the re-adoption of ordinances in 1997.

Ordinance 5

Iron River Township Liquor Control Ordinance

An ordinance to secure the public peace, health and safety of the residence and property owners of the Township, for the regulation of alcoholic liquor traffic within said Township, throughout the enforcement of the Michigan Liquor Control Act of the State of Michigan within said township; to provide penalties for the violation of said ordinance; and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict thereof.

Ordinance 6

Designating Certain Areas for carrying on Certain Trades of Employment

An ordinance assigning certain areas or places for the exercising of certain trades or employment offensive to the inhabitants of the Township, or dangerous to the public health and forbidding the exercise thereof in places not so designated.

Ordinance 7

Permitting Construction or Remodeling or Moving of Buildings & Structures in the Township

An ordinance to require permits for construction, remodeling, or moving of all buildings and structures in the Township which exceeds the value of \$100.00, for the purpose of assisting the township assessor in obtaining a greater degree of accuracy in the assessment of properties therein, and to promote the safety, sanitation, public health and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Township, and to provide penalties for its violation.

Ordinance 8

Prohibiting Sewage Disposal Systems and Maintaining Garbage near Township Water Wells

An ordinance prohibiting the installation, operation, or maintenance of any sanitary sewage line, septic tank, sewage disposal systems, privy, inside toilet, or any sewage or garbage within a certain radius of any Township well furnishing water to the inhabitants of the Township; and providing penalties for its violation.

Ordinance 9

Giving MI Consolidated Gas Easements to Lay Pipe

An ordinance giving consent to Michigan Consolidated Gas Company to lay, maintain, operate and use gas pipes, mains, conductors, service pipes and other necessary equipment in the highways, streets, alleys and other public places in the Township. Also to transact local business in the Township for the purpose of conveying gas into and through, and supplying and selling gas in said Township.

Ordinance 10 replaced with Ordinance 16

Ordinance 11

Reject Fluoridation of Township Water Supply

An ordinance rejecting that required eventual fluoridation of the drinking water of the Township water supply.

Ordinance 12

Regulating Cross Connections with the Public Water Supply

An ordinance regulating cross connections with the public water supply system; i.e. a connection or arrangement of piping or appurtenances through which water of questionable quality, wastes, or other contaminants can enter the public water supply system.

Ordinance 13

Regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for safe use waters in the Township

An ordinance to regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in the Township.

Ordinance 14

Designate and appoint the Iron County Dog Warden and Deputy Sheriff as Dog Warden

An ordinance to designate and appoint the Iron County Dog Warden and Deputy Sheriff as dog warden for the Township.

Ordinance 15

Establish the Fiscal Year and Annual Statement Day

An ordinance to establish the fiscal year of the Township and the annual settlement day for Township pursuant to.

Ordinance 16

Repeal Ordinance 10, as amended, and Replace With New

An ordinance to repeal Ordinance 10 and replace same with a new ordinance (16), and amend as the "Township Rural Zoning Act" for the establishment of zoning districts in the unincorporated portions of the Township.

Ordinance 17

Open Burning of Certain Combustible Materials

An ordinance prohibiting the open burning of certain combustible materials and the penalty thereof if the ordinance is violated.

Ordinance 18

Authorizing issuance of Sewage Disposal System Revenue Bonds

An ordinance authorizing the issuance of sewage disposal system revenue bonds by the Township for the purpose of constructing a sewage disposal system for said Township; providing for the collection of revenue from system for the purpose of paying the costs of operation and maintenance, and providing for other matters relative to said bonds, and said system.

Ordinance 19**Regulating the use of public and private sewers and drains, etc.**

An ordinance regulating the use of public and private sewers and drains, the installation and connection of building sewers and the discharge of waters and wastes into the Township's sewer system, and establishing, and providing for the collection of rates and charges for use of the Township's system.

Ordinance 20**Electrical Code**

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agent to discharge the responsibilities of the Township under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act (Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended).

Ordinance 21**Anti-Littering**

An ordinance to define, control and prohibit the littering of public and private property, roads, parks, ditches, or other adjoining lands; and to establish the penalty for the violation of this ordinance.

Amendment to Ordinance 21

An amendment to Ordinance 21 to delete existing Section 12 with reference to the penalties if in violation of this ordinance.

Ordinance 23**Open storage of Disabled Automobile and Repair**

An ordinance prohibiting a disabled motor vehicle to be parked, stored, placed, or allowed to remain within the Township, with the penalty for the violation of the ordinance.

Ordinance 24**Fire Fees & Charges**

An ordinance providing for the billing and collection of costs of providing fire protection and other public safety service to the Township and penalty for the violation of this ordinance.

Ordinance 25**Land Divisions**

An ordinance to regulate partitioning or division of parcels or tracts of land, enacted pursuant but not limited to Michigan Public Act 288 of 1967

Ordinance 26**Water Utility Policy**

An ordinance to regulate and control the construction, installation, extension, service connection, and operation of public water service within the Township of Iron River; to prescribe procedures for securing such public water service, and the rates and charges for the same, and set forth general policy for Use, Abandonment, Abuse, and to provide penalties for the violation of such ordinance regulations
