

Regular Meeting October 12, 2021

Iron River Township Hall 6:00 PM

Members Present: Scott Tarsi, Supervisor; Doug Bruster, Trustee; Mike Sheehy, Trustee; Amber Laturi, Clerk.

Member Absent: Dawn Pisoni, Treasurer.

Present: Dennis Tousignant – Legal.

Motion made by Mike Sheehy to accept the minutes of September 14th. Motion was supported by Doug Bruster. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the agenda with one addition of Propane bids was made by Amber Laturi and supported by Mike Sheehy. Motion carried.

Scott Tarsi read the assessor's report.

Motion to accept the one bid for propane from Krist Oil for \$1.79 per gallon was made by Doug Bruster and motion was supported by Mike Sheehy. Roll call taken. Motion passed 4-0.

Discussion regarding the proposal from KCI to print winter tax bills and sort and mail first class for an estimated cost of \$1149.92. This would be approximately \$200 more than printing them in house and mailing like we have done in the past. Dawn Pisoni used this service for printing and mailing the summer tax bills and she found it was very efficient and professional. Motion to approve KCI for the winter tax bills was made by Doug Bruster and supported by Amber Laturi. Roll call was taken. Motion passed 4-0.

The board discussed proposed changes to the Zoning Administrator Ordinance. The Planning Commission met on September 29, 2021. The Planning commission discussed and recommended an amendment to the Zoning Administrator's duties. The Planning commission agreed to strike current Article XX Zoning Administrator 20.2.2 language and replace with "Shall not have any delinquent accounts due to the township" and Proposed New Article XX Zoning Administration 20.2.4 was discussed – language being "Requiring Zoning Administrator to visit proposed job site and issue permit". The article will be removed that prohibits any Township board member to hold this position. Scott Tarsi suggested that, if possible, to add the requirement to have a survey completed so that a possible problem can be avoided. Motion was made by Scott Tarsi to approve the changes to the ordinance and supported by Mike Sheehy. Motion carried. 4-0.

Scott Tarsi reported on the West Iron County Sewer Authority and Windsor Center, reports are available if anyone in the public is interested.

The treasurer report was provided and no questions for the month of September.

Jason Cole reported on the water and sewer departments.

The Prosecutor Chad DeRouin was present to introduce himself.

Motion to approve the bills for the month was made by Doug Bruster supported by Mike Sheehy. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 4-0.
