

Regular Meeting June 10, 2025

Motion made by Marla Hill to accept the minutes for the regular meeting on May 13th. The motion was supported by Scott Tarsi. Motion carried. 5-0

The motion to accept the agenda as written by Mike Sheehy and supported by Wes Hill. Motion carried. 5-0.

Craig Richardson from Wick Wire was present and updated the board on the new DPW building. Craig Richardson presented the pay request #1 for Smith Metal in the amount of \$138,890. Motion made by Amber Laturi to approve the pay request #1 and supported by Mike Sheehy. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0

Craig Richardson presented the letter regarding the Nelson Field Football Field and Tennis Court Lighting upgrades. Over the past few years, the need has arisen to upgrade the football field and tennis court lighting at Nelson Field. Fundraising is currently underway in the efforts to pay for the new light fixtures and get them installed before the fall sports season begins. So far \$85,000 has been raised. Over the years the Township has been made aware that the township is not allowed to donate funds. We can check with our auditors to confirm this.

Scott Tarsi read the Assessor's report.

Brett was present from ICECA and asked if there were any questions or concerns.

Rachel Gramham was present to report on the Windsor Center. The Windsor center is making progress with the rental rates and being fair across the board.

The water and sewer rates were discussed. The Sewer rates are revised as each customer shall be charged \$5.33 for each 1,000 gallons metered with a minimum charge based on 4,500 gallons. The Water rates are revised as each customer shall be charged \$6.67 for each 1,000 gallons metered with a minimum of charge based on 4,500 gallons. Motion made by Amber Laturi to approve the revised rates for the Water and Sewer and supported by Scott Tarsi. Motion carried. 5-0.

Motion made by Amber Laturi and supported by Scott Tarsi to approve the amendment of agreement for Joint Public Building Restoration Administrative Board. This removes the section stating there is a shared cost for any shortages in the budget. Motion carried. 5-0

Scott Tarsi reported on the West Iron County Sewer Authority and the West Iron County Fire Board meetings. Water leak fixed on Iron Lake Road by Don James and Jeff Viitala's residences. Water meters are being worked on and approximately have 39 more meters that we will need a plumber to install. The order has been placed for the meters needed for residences currently without a meter.

Scott Tarsi reported that a resident asked if he could hook up water service on Gendron Road. There are currently 3 customers on this line and the resident was told that there is no guarantee that the water service would not be discontinued in the future due to a small number of residents on this long of a line.

Marla Hill presented the treasurer's report for the month of May.

The motion to approve the bills for the month was made by Mike Sheehy supported by Scott Tarsi. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0.
