

# **Regular Meeting November 11, 2025**

## **Iron River Township Hall 6:00 PM**

Members Present: Scott Tarsi, Supervisor; Westley Hill, Trustee; Amber Laturi, Clerk; Marla Hill, Treasurer; and Mike Sheehy, Trustee. Present: Dennis Tousignant – Legal.

Motion made by Mike Sheehy to accept the minutes for the regular meeting on October 14<sup>th</sup>. The motion was supported by Marla Hill. Motion carried. 5-0

The motion to accept the agenda with no additions was made by Mike Sheehy and motion was supported by Wes Hill. Motion carried. 5-0.

Craig Richardson from Wick Wire was present and updated the board on the new DPW building and presented the pay request #6 for Smith Metal in the amount of \$120,175.00. Motion made by Amber Laturi to approve the pay request #5 and supported by Mike Sheehy. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0.

Zach Hautala from the ICECA was not present but did email a report to the board. Motion made by Amber Laturi to approve an ad for the Visitor Guide for \$160.00. Motion supported by Mike Sheehy. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0.

Scott Tarsi read the assessor report provided by Heather Casagrande.

Rachel Gramann was present and reported on the Windsor Center.

The Chicaugon Lake Property Owners Association asked for support for their Wagner Creek Culvert Removal and Bridge Replacement Project. Motion made by Amber Laturi to write a letter of support for the project. Motion supported by Marla Hill. Motion carried. 5-0

Scott Tarsi and Ryker Johnson reported on the water and sewer departments. We had a resident on Bloomquist that had a tap in over 3 years ago. He called reporting that his water pressure was very low. Scott Tarsi found that when the water tap was completed by the township the tap was not drilled enough and that was the reason why he was not getting enough water pressure. Scott Tarsi and Ryker Johnson fixed the issue, and the customer is now very happy. Penny Daniels had reported to the township that she has to let her water run in the winter to avoid freezing. Scott Tarsi and Ryker Johnson dug up the line and there should now be no reason to let the water run. The parking lot for the new building is completed and the new DPW building sign is installed. The bore is scheduled for Carl Johnson on Ottawa Lake Road and for Dale and Judy Carlson on Smokey Lake Road. This will resolve the issues, and they will not have to run their water. The meter pit will be removed from Carl Johnson's side; we will be able to tell if there is freezing where the problem is.

Nathan Holm reported on the zoning.

The motion to approve the bills for the month was made by Mike Sheehy supported by Wes Hill. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0.
