

Regular Meeting April 13, 2021

Iron River Township Hall 6:00 PM

Members Present: Scott Tarsi, Supervisor; Mike Sheehy, Trustee; Doug Bruster, Trustee; Amber Laturi, Clerk and Dawn Pisoni, Treasurer. Present: Dennis Tousignant – Legal.

Motion made by Mike Sheehy to accept the minutes of March 16th. Motion was supported by Doug Bruster. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the agenda with one addition – parcel of land was made by Mike Sheehy and supported by Amber Laturi. Motion carried.

Kim Schmidt was present. The board discussed his contract and Doug Bruster made a motion to accept his one-year contract. Motion was supported by Mike Sheehy. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0 The board also discussed the proposal from Waisanen Assessing & GIS Mapping for \$4400.00 which includes \$2900 for update of existing shapefiles and create new GIS map, and \$1500 for publish parcel assessment and tax map online and includes 4 updates per year and this will be a yearly fee. Motion was made by Mike Sheehy to accept the proposal and supported by Amber Laturi. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0

The current owners of the Sukaniva farm when their property was surveyed found that the township owns a small strip of land and is asking the township if they would be interested in selling the piece. The township is going to research in the minutes to see what the minutes show regarding the ownership of the property.

Scott Tarsi reported on the West Iron County Sewer Authority and Windsor Center, reports are available if anyone in the public is interested. Scott Tarsi reported that the township fence around the Nash tank is on the neighbor's property. We could move the fence depending on the cost or we may need to think about purchasing a small piece from the current owner to resolve this issue.

The township received the invoice for Old Beechwood Road from the Iron County Road Commission in the amount of \$274,927.65. Scott Tarsi wanted the board to know that there could be \$11,000 for administration fee, as the Road Commission is undecided if they are waiving this fee. Motion made by Scott Tarsi to approve the invoice for the Old Beechwood Road, and supported by Doug Bruster. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0

The treasurer report was provided and no questions for the month of March.

Jason Cole reported on the water and sewer departments.

Motion to approve the bills for the month was made by Doug Bruster supported by Amber Laturi. Roll call taken. Motion carried. 5-0.
