

Regular Meeting November 9, 2021

Motion made by Mike Sheehy to accept the minutes of October 12th. Motion was supported by Doug Bruster. Motion carried.

Motion made by Mike Sheehy to accept the agenda as presented. Motion was supported by Dawn Pisoni. Motion carried.

Scott Tarsi read the assessor's report.

Discussion about the County GIS during the County Commissioner agenda item. Without a commissioner present, Scott Tarsi said there needs to be something in writing from the Board of Commissioners to join the County wide GIS system.

Scott Tarsi reported on the West Iron County Sewer Authority and Windsor Center, reports are available if anyone in the public is interested.

Scott Tarsi mentioned that the dump truck has a broken box hinge and is not worth fixing. Possible use of the American Rescue Plan Act Funds to purchase a new dump truck.

The treasurer report was provided and no questions for the month of November. Dawn Pisoni noted that the final payment was issued to the Road Commission. The schedule for future road repairs is Bernhardt Road, Hamner Road, Iron Lake Road and Dobson Drive.

Lisa Coates from the Polich Tousignant Law Offices presented changes to Zoning Permit XXI 21.1 and new language in 21.1a. The new language does not specify that the Zoning Administrator must be on site to approve the zoning permit. Therefore, new resolution language will be presented at the next regular meeting for approval.

This is the discussion and motion from the October 12, 2021 board meeting:

The board discussed proposed changes to the Zoning Administrator Ordinance. The Planning Commission met on September 29, 2021. The Planning commission discussed and recommended an amendment to the Zoning Administrator's duties. The Planning commission agreed to strike current Article XX Zoning Administrator 20.2.2 language and replace with "Shall not have any delinquent accounts due to the township" and Proposed New Article XX Zoning Administration 20.2.4 was discussed – language being "Requiring Zoning Administrator to visit proposed job site and issue permit". The article will be removed that prohibits any Township board member to hold this position. Scott Tarsi suggested that, if possible, to add the requirement to have a survey completed so that a possible problem can be avoided. Motion was made by Scott Tarsi to approve the changes to the ordinance and supported by Mike Sheehy. Motion carried. 4-0.

Jason Cole reported on the water and sewer departments.

Motion to approve the bills for the month was made by Mike Sheehy supported by Dawn Pisoni. Motion Carried.
